Tenders are invited for the: Daniëlskuil: Refurbishment of Water Infrastructure

One complete set of documents will be available from Kgatelopele Municipality Offices, Barker Street, Daniëlskuil, (053) 384-8600 from **22 June 2018** upon payment of an amount of R 700.00 (Seven Hundred Rand and Zero cents), which is non-refundable. Only cash payment at the Municipal Office or electronic funds transfer payable to **Kgatelopele Local Municipality** will be accepted. Interested tenderers can obtain a document from Kgatelopele Municipality Offices, Barker Street, Daniëlskuil, from **10:00 on Friday, 22 June 2018**. The Tender Documents will also be available at the compulsory site inspection meeting in Daniëlskuil.

Tenders in sealed envelopes and clearly endorsed:

Tender No WSIG/CE/2828/PHASE 4/2018: Daniëlskuil: Refurbishment of Water Infrastructure must be addressed to the Municipal Manager, Kgatelopele Local Municipality, and must be placed in the **Tender Box, Kgatelopele Municipality Offices, Barker Street, Daniëlskuil, 8405**

not later than **12:00 on Friday, 13 July 2018** which Tenders will be opened in public the same day in the offices of the Municipality.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at **11:00 on Friday, 22 June 2018**. The Engineer will be present at the briefing and all questions will then be answered. No further visits to the site will take place. Persons taking interest will gather at the **Council Chambers, Kgatelopele Municipality Offices, Barker Street, Daniëlskuil, 8405**. **Tenderers, who do not attend the compulsory site inspection, will expose their tenders to rejection.**

Only Tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders. Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in line with the Supply Chain Management policy of the municipality using an 80/20 preference points system.

Bids will be evaluated on Functionality:

The bid will be evaluated on functionality with the following criterion:

Quality criteria	Maximum number of points
Experience of Tenderer on similar projects	30
Key personnel proposed for the project: Qualification and experience	20
Construction schedule and availability of resources/plant	35
Bank rating	15
Maximum possible score for quality (M_s)	100

NB: Bidders must score a minimum of 70% to be considered for further evaluation.

Tenders must be registered with the CIDB in a CE Class of Construction Works (**Grade 5 CE or higher**) and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with *Regulation 25(1B) OR 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulation, 2004*.

In accordance with Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 Clause 4(1)(a), tenderers must have a **Level 1 B-BBEE Contributors**.

Clause 4(1)(c) **30% of the contract value be sub-contracted** out to the following criteria:

- (i) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people; and/or
- (ii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth; and/or
- (iii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women; and/or
- (iv) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities; and/or
- (v) an EME or QSE which is 51% owned by black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships.

30% of the contract value that is subcontracted will be split amongst three subcontracting companies.

The sub-contractors must be fully compliant on Central Supplier Database (CSD) and be registered with the CIDB under the CE Class, having a designation in the 2CE or higher class, as required.

NB: Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the municipality.

Kgatelopele Local Municipality reserves the right to accept a part of a Tender and does not bind itself to accept the lowest and/or any Tender. Their Tenders must bind Tenderers for a period of **90 (Ninety) days** after Tender Closing Date. No Tenders or copies of Tenders received by facsimile machine, electronic mail or per telegram will be considered. Tenderers attempting to influence the Client with regard to the awarding of the Tender, after Tender closure, will automatically expose their Tenders to rejection.
